
Pallet:

Other Materials

What You Should Consider:

Vinyl More expensive than wood options, with volatile pricing tied to tariffs, currency changes and the petroleum market. Prone to mildew in humid or

wet climates, and has an artificial appearance.

3/4" Western Red Cedar (S1S2E)

Primarily sourced from Canada, leaving it prone to tariff price increases in addition to the diminishing supply; means more expensive and less available than domestic redwood. A by-product of lumber mills rather than a dedicated fencing material, leading to inconsistencies in quality and supply.

Red Cedar

%6" Western Contrary to popular belief, Western Red Cedar is not sustainably harvested, as its population diminishes each year. It offers decent durability, but its resistance to rot and insects can be inconsistent, along with flaws like wane and thickness. Compared to redwood, it typically requires more maintenance and lacks the same long-term performance.

Douglas Fir A sturdier option than other whitewoods, offering better structural integrity and resistance to decay. However, it lacks the natural beauty and rich tones of redwood and often requires additional treatment for longevity.

Import Often sourced from Asia or South America, making it more costly, prone to tariff fluctuations, scarce, prone to supply chain issues and inconsistent quality. Performance, longevity, and sustainability are inferior to domestic redwood.

Incense A native California wood, but with a shorter Cedar lifespan than redwood. Prone to mildew, insect damage, and shrinkage. Typically marketed as a budget-friendly alternative, but does not match redwood's premium aesthetic and durability.

Stained Whitewood

Pre-stained softwood has a lower cost than redwood but lacking the same natural resilience and longevity. While it offers initial visual appeal, it cannot match redwood's long-term performance.

Treated

Pressure Made from whitewood species such as South American pine or southern yellow pine. Chemically treated to resist decay, but often less aesthetically pleasing and more prone to warping over time.
